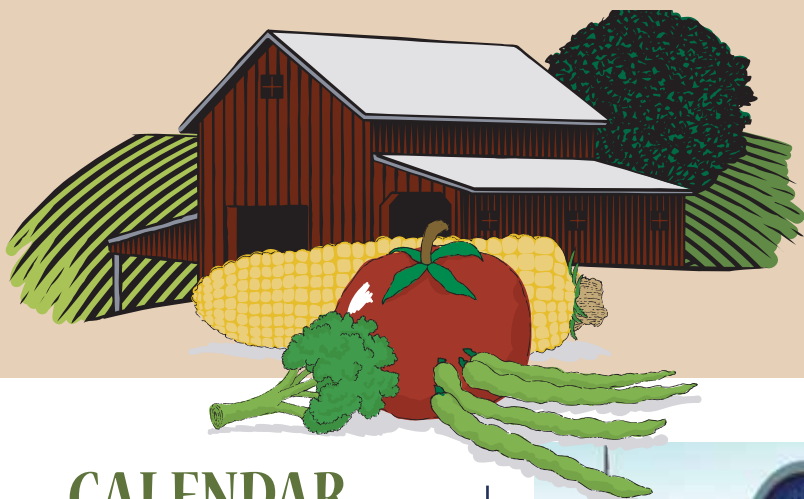

Torte de Pesche

(Peach & Ricotta Pie)

- ¼ cup butter
- ½ cup sugar
- Pinch of salt
- 2 eggs separated
- 1/3 cup cornstarch
- 8 oz. Ricotta cheese, sieved
- Zest and juice of one lemon
- 2 tbsp toasted ground almonds
- 3 large yellow peaches, pitted, sliced thin
- ¼ cup bread crumbs
- 2 tbsp confectioner's sugar

Beat the butter, sugar and salt together till creamy. Add the egg yolks one by one followed by the ricotta. Mix in the lemon and zest, corn starch and almonds. Beat the egg whites till stiff, fold gently into butter mixture. Add thinly sliced peaches. Pour into greased 8" pie pan that you have coated with bread crumbs. Bake in preheated 325 degree oven for about 1 hour. Dust with confectioner's sugar. Serve warm with ice cream. Serves 4 Wine: Sweet white
